- **Apache Tomcat** is an open source Java **servlet** container that functions as a *web server*, developed by the Apache Software Foundation (ASF).

- Apache Tomcat vs. Apache HTTPD (Apache HTTP Server httpd.apache.org)
 - HTTPD – the world's most used web server (52.1%, July 2016). Written in C: static web pages + add-on modules for dynamic contents; e.g., Perl, PHP, Python, etc.
 - Tomcat – written in Java: Java servlets, JSP; can also serve static contents
 - mod_jk – an Apache module to connect Tomcat with other web servers such as Apache HTTPD







The HTML interface is protected against CSRF but the text and JMX interfaces are not. To maintain the CSRF protection:

- Users with the `manager-gui` role should not be granted either the `manager-script` or `manager-jmx` roles.
- If the text or jmx interfaces are accessed through a browser (e.g. for testing since these interfaces are intended for tools not humans) then the browser must be closed afterwards to terminate the session.

- Under Tomcat's source code directory:
 - Copy *build.properties.default* to *build.properties*
 - Edit *build.properties*:
 - Change: base.path=\${user.home}/tomcat-build-libs
 - To: base.path=temp1

All temporary files will be downloaded to the temp1 directory under Tomcat's source code directory
 - Run Ant to build/rebuild: ant
 - A usable Tomcat will be in: Tomcat source\output\build
